Bulky Waste & Brush

Bulky waste and brush will be collected on Wednesdays.

You are limited to four (4) cubic yards of bulky waste and brush per week.

Place all bulk and brush items at your normal pickup location no later than 7:00 am, for collection between 7:00 am

and 7:00 pm. Please do not place items out more than 12 hours before your pickup day.

1 cubic yard is equivalent to 1 washing machine

Bulky Waste - Acceptable

Toys and Yard Tools Tagged as "Bulk Item"

Furniture

Bundled Carpet in 4-foot Lengths

Fence Panels No Larger than 4'x6'

Thorny Vines (Must be bagged or in containers)

Washing Machines, Dryers, Water Heaters and Kitchen Appliances

Refrigerators/Freezers (Must be tagged certifying removal of refrigerants)

Bulky Waste - Prohibited

Single Items Weighing More than 150 Pounds

Commercial Construction/Remodeling Debris

Concrete, Rock, Stone, etc.

Household Hazardous Waste

Tires, Batteries, and Propane Tanks

Loose Debris st be placed in heavy duty bag

(Debris must be placed in heavy duty bags or in boxes or other containers no larger than 2'x2'x4' that weigh no more than 50 pounds.)

Loose Brush Guidelines

Limbs should be no greater than six (6) inches in diameter, nor weigh more than 50 pounds.

Limbs should not be more than 10 feet long.

Brush pile must be free from all bulk and foreign debris.

Place brush close to street; please do not block the sidewalk.



HHW & Used Electronics

Household Hazardous Waste & Used Electronics Door-side Collection



CWD's Door-side Collection program encourages safe, easy, and responsible disposal of approved hazardous waste and electronics.

Items accepted via the HHW Door-side Collection program include poison, solvent, oil-based and latex paint, aerosols, used motor oil, auto batteries, fluorescent tubes, and televisions.

How to Prepare for your HHW Collection:

- 1. Call CWD at 972.392.9300, Option 2.
- 2. CWD will mail you a collection kit.
- 3. Assemble your HHW and used electronics according to the instructions provided.
- 4. Place your HHW and used electronics at your doorstep by 7:00am on your service day, where CWD will pick it up.

Separate recycling and trash containers by five (5) feet and place away from any obstacles such as mailboxes, cars, fences, drainage ditches, etc., with a 16-foot clearance above the cart(s).
